
## **CONSIDER THE SOURCE**

**READ BEYOND** Headlines can be outrageous in an effort to get clicks. What's the whole story?





**SUPPORTING**

**CHECK THE AUTHOR** Do a quick search on the author. *Are they credible? Are they real?*

**BIASES** Consider if your own beliefs could affect your judgement.



**ASK THE EXPERTS** 

Ask a librarian, trusted adult or consult a fact-checking site.

## What if someone is sharing fake news on my feed?

**Call it out!** Let them know that what they have shared is untrue. Screenshot, report and block on the platform.
